BioSilta are honoured to receive the BioFinland prize of 10 000 Euros which is only awarded for the second time, the first recipient of the award was Finnzymes in 2005, BioSilta joins prestigious company and would be delighted to emulate the success of the former recipient. The Biosilta Oy is a University of Oulu and Biocenter Oulu spin-off company founded by Professor Peter Neubauer in 2007. The use of controlled growth environment can result in up to 50-fold enhancement in protein production, or greatly improve quality of produced products. The company has customers currently in Finland, Sweden, Germany, Great Britain and United States.
